

Christ Is Unique

Christians believe Jesus Christ of Nazareth is the Son of God who came to earth in human flesh (Mat 1:18-20; Jn 1:1-17). Others have denied or discredited the Christian belief and equate Him with being a good man [Muslims], a prophet among many prophets or a guru [Hindu- one with great knowledge] and with high moral standards. Agnostics do not see in Christ anything to admire and place Him below Buddha and Socrates [Bertand Russell]. Christ is, in spite of the reproaches cast upon Him, the centerpiece of Christianity. The truth about Christ is derived from the Bible alone. These documents have been proven to be reliable, historically correct and the only legitimate resource on the life and times of Jesus Christ. From these we learn the multi faceted life of Jesus Christ. Jesus is described and acclaimed to be both God and man, a unity of humanity and divinity. Uniquely the New Testament says Christ was, is and will be fully God, who in a span of 33 years lived in human flesh and was fully man (Phil 23:1-18). Deny or acclaim Him He is unique because He is above all other religious leaders or persons who ever lived and can be authenticated from factual evidence.

Jesus Christ was supernatural. He lived a miracle filled life from His birth to ascension to the right hand of the Father. He was endowed with supernatural powers [miracles, prophecies and many infallible proofs Heb 2:1-5]. The Old Testament, incredibly reliable, predicted where (Mic 5:2), when (Dan 9:6), how (Isa 7:14), why (Isa 9:6, 7) and what family (Isa 11:1-9). He was to be born of Adam's race (1 Cor 15:33-49; Gen 4:26), born of woman (Gen 3:15, 16), through Noah's son Shem (Gen 4:26), of Abraham (Gen 12:3; 15:5) and of the tribe of Judah (Gen 49:10). David would be His paternal and maternal grandfather (2 Sam 7:12-15; Acts 2:14-36; Mat 1:1-17; Lk 3:23-38). He would die and be raised from the dead (Isa 53: Psm 22: 2:7: 16:10: Dan 9:26: Zech 12:10). All of these supernatural prophecies were fulfilled only in Jesus Christ of Nazareth. No other leader of a world religion has such creditable credentials.

Being conceived by a virgin, who was overpowered by the Holy Spirit, sets Jesus Christ apart from all other human beings (Mat 1:18-23). Jesus is unique and miraculously identified as God with us. Jesus' ministry was filled with miracles (Jn 2:11; Acts 2:22). His miracles were immediate, always successful, seen and known, worked upon incurable illnesses from blindness

to leprosy and raising the dead (Jn 11). All natural laws were under His control. He was the God of creation and could perform miracles which did wondrous things that none other could do. He walked on the water (Mat 14:25), turned water into wine (Jn 2:7-10), multiplied bread and fishes (Jn 9:7-15), made the blind to see (Jn 9:1-10), healed many diseased individuals who came to Him. When they asked Him if He was the Messiah He used His miracles as evidence in support of His divine mission and person. Those who heard Him said He was sent from God (Jn 3:1-16).

In His death the miraculous was present. The darkness from noon to 3p.m. (Mk 15:33), the earthquake opened tombs of the righteous and the temple veil was rent (Mat 27:47-55). Jesus was miraculously raised from the dead by the glory of the Father (Rom 6:1-11). He had predicted that if they destroyed the temple in three days it would be raised (Jn 2:19-21; Mat 12:39-44; 17:9). Jesus appeared to His disciples and over 500 brethren (1 Cor 15:1-5). Jesus demonstrated that he was resurrected by spending forty days with the disciples before His ascension. He was miraculously able to ascend into heaven while His apostles looked on (Acts 1:1-10). He bodily ascended into heaven and will return (Acts 1:11; 1 Thes 4:13-18; 1 Cor 15:1-58). The sinless one who died, was buried in a borrowed tomb, raised by glorious power, ascended to the Father's right hand and is now our Mediator (1 Tim 2:1-8).

Jesus was the epitome of all that is virtuous. He exemplified virtue and purity. Even His critics were astounded by His character traits. His love was beyond comparison and stands as the means to measure perfect love (Jn 13:31-35; 1 Jn 3; Rom 5:1-10). No other world religion has such a foundation as the love Jesus demands of His church. Jesus was in perfect accord with His Father at all times, His teachings were perfect (Mat 5-7). His patience and compassion was exceedingly wonderful (Mat 23:37; 9:6). He was the perfect example of humility as He washed the disciples feet and boldly claimed He was one with the Father((Jn 15; 10:30).He was meek and lowly but full of zeal when he turned over tables in the temple (Mat 11:28; Jn 2). He was kind and candid (Mat 23).

Jesus declared that His ministry was to seek and save the lost (Lk 19:10). His teachings were rooted in the Old Testament but He said he came to fulfill it not destroy it (Mat 5:13-18). His sermons were fresh and new but were filled with ancient quotes to prove His points. He gave parables [dark sayings] but brought light into the world (Jn 8:12; Mat 5:11-13). He confounded the teachers of His day, enlightened His followers giving them the Holy Spirit who guided them unto all truth (Jn 16:13-25).

Christ was superior in every way, from His deity, humanity, miracles, unimpeachable teachings, to His religious and moral essence. Jesus Christ of Nazareth defined what those who followed Him would be by manifesting the way, the truth and the life (Jn 14:1-5).

FAMILY CARE A Message from Our Shepherds

"All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work" (2 Tim 3:16-17). It is God's will that we should live the Christian life. He not only gives us a command and an example, but He also gives us power to live for Christ. One source of god's power is His Word as see in the above scripture.

What are some facts concerning the Word of God? First it is divinely inspired. Verse 16 says that "All Scripture is given by inspiration of God..." There should be no doubt in our minds about this. The Word of God is also absolutely pure (Psa 12:6). If we contrast lying, deceit, blasphemy, and impurity of the words of men; God's Word has been tried in the furnace on earth. We also learn that it is the supreme authority. Jesus endorsed it: "It is written." We see this phrase used over 61 different times in the New Testament. We should be reminded what was said in Revelation 22:18-19 "For I testify to everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: If anyone adds to these things, God will add to him the plagues that are written in this book; and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part from the Book of Life, from the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book." Yes, God's Word is the supreme authority. We also recognize that it is eternally permanent. "But the word of the LORD endures forever." Now this is the word which by the gospel was preached to you" (1 Pet 1:25). What a wonderful truth that God's Word will always eternally exist. The problem with us is we are the ones who change and can make wise and unwise choices in life but God's Word never changes. Jerry McKey
