Rightly Dividing the Word

Recently, a person high up in a denominational hierarchy lost his position due to teaching he had made in 2000 during an interview. He was asked "What do you recommend for women who are undergoing genuine physical abuse from their husbands, and the husbands say they should be submitting?" based on Eph 5:22 and Paul's command for "wives (to) submit unto your own husbands."

His response was "It depends on the level of abuse to some degree." He went on to explain that he had counseled a woman in an abusive relationship to "get down by your bed just as he (her husband) goes to sleep ... and when you think he's just about asleep, you just pray and ask God to intervene," but to 'Get ready because he may get a little more violent, you know, when he discovers this.' Sure enough, the woman later showed up at the church with two black eyes!

First, it is never appropriate under any circumstances for a man to abuse a woman and especially for a husband to abuse his wife and/or his children! In every instance where a man abuses a woman, the problem is NOT with the woman, but with the man! There is NEVER an acceptable level of abuse from a man to a woman.

For us to pretend that none of this occurs in the Lord's church or that there are not Christians who either abuse women or think it is OK unless it is at an "acceptable level" would be naive on our part. The most important point is that any agreement with this type of belief is 100% contrary to the truth of God's Word and the way that God demands that men treat women.

What if we rightly divide God's word on this subject? The Bible does say in Eph 5:22 that "wives are to submit themselves to their husbands." To rightly divide God's Word would be to start at vs. 21 where Paul says <u>husbands and wives</u> were to "submit (ting) yourselves to one another..." Paul actually spends most of the time talking about the <u>husbands</u> responsibilities to "love your wives as Christ loved the church" (vs. 25), "love their wives as their own bodies" (vs. 28), to "nourish and cherish" their wives (vs. 29), and to "love his wife even as himself" (vs. 33). Peter says in 1 Pet 3:7, "Husbands, likewise, dwell with *them* with understanding, giving honor to the wife, as to the weaker vessel, and as *being* heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers may not be hindered." Finally, Paul writes in Col. 3:19, "Husbands, love your wives and do not be bitter toward them."

Had this individual rightly divided God's Word, his "counseling" might have taken a completely different direction. As teachers of God's Word, we are to carefully consider what we teach because we will be held accountable for that teaching (James 3:1). We should always make sure that we consider the "whole counsel of God" (Acts 20:7) and that we always "rightly divide the Word of truth" (2 Tim 2:15).
