

### Parenting 101

"Parents arrested in California after toddler sons found in cages" blasted the headlines recently. "Two parents in northern California were arrested for child endangerment after authorities allegedly found their two toddler sons inside cages bolted to a bedroom wall." I am not sure how you "allegedly" find children in cages, but that is another question for another time.

More and more it seems that we read and hear about children who have been abused, killed, and even "sold" by their own parents. I worked with abused children so I know first-hand how cruel parents can be to their own children. It is horrifying to see what is done to children by their own parents. You can blame it on drugs, alcohol, "anger issues," frustration, or apathy, but the bottom line is the children always suffer.

There are no "experts" who know more than God about parenting. The Bible says children are a "heritage from the Lord...a reward" and bring happiness. (Ps. 127:3-5) Parents are commanded to train a child in the way that they are to go for their entire lives. (Prov. 22:6) Included in their training is developing their own parenting skills. We instill in them the ability to be good adults, fathers, husbands, mothers, and wives. (Prov. 4:3-4) We train our children in the admonition of the Lord. (Eph. 6:4) Obviously God would never approve or condone putting our children in a cage, either because we didn't want to deal with them or as some perverted form of punishment.

Because so many parents today are abusing children, many Christians have bought into the devil's lie that children must <u>not</u> be disciplined by their parents. The truth is, parents who refuse to train and discipline their children are in defiance of God's commandments. "Do not withhold correction from a child..." (Prov. 23:13) Since "Foolishness is bound up in the heart of a child; The rod of correction will drive it far from him." (Prov. 22:15) Discipline is part of the training of the child and is essential to their development as adults. "The rod and rebuke give wisdom..." (Prov. 29:15)

Discipline is difficult and never easy to administer. But discipline is critical for our children. Some parents won't discipline because they say they "love" their children too much. This is not true according to God. "He who spares his rod hates his son, But he who loves him disciplines him promptly." (Prov. 13:24; Rev. 3:19) When we discipline our children properly in a Godly manner, we "deliver his soul from hell." (Prov. 23:14) Likewise, our children are commanded to listen to instruction (Prov. 4:1-2; 7:24) and accept the training and discipline of parents. (Heb. 12:5-10)

The problem is easy to understand. Too many people want children but do not want to be parents. Children require parents. Children are NOT capable of parenting themselves! (Prov. 29:15) Prior to having children, everyone should consider whether they want to or are prepared to be parents. If they do not want to be parents, do not have children! Children are too precious to ever be mistreated or unloved by their parents. (Luke 17:2; Matt. 18:10)
