"If thou put the brethren in mind of these things, thou shalt be a good minister of Christ Jesus, nourished in the words of the faith, and of the good doctrine which thou hast followed until now: but refuse profane and old wives' fables. And exercise thyself unto godliness: for bodily exercise is profitable for a little; but godliness is profitable for all things, having promise of the life which now is, and of that which is to come. Faithful is the saying, and worthy of all acceptation. For to this end we labor and strive, because we have our hope set on the living God, who is the Saviour of all men, specially of them that believe. These things command and teach. Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an ensample to them that believe, in word, in manner of life, in love, in faith, in purity. Till I come, give heed to reading, to exhortation, to teaching. Neglect not the gift that is in thee, which was given thee by prophecy, with the laying on of the hands of the presbytery. Be diligent in these things; give thyself wholly to them; that thy progress may be manifest unto all. Take heed to thyself, and to thy teaching. Continue in these things; for in doing this thou shalt save both thyself and them that hear thee" (1 Tim 4:6-16).

Holy People

"For thou art a holy people unto Jehovah thy God: Jehovah thy God hath chosen thee to be a people for his own possession, above all peoples that are upon the face of the earth. Jehovah did not set his love upon you, nor choose you, because ye were more in number than any people; for ye were the fewest of all peoples: but because Jehovah loveth you, and because he would keep the oath which he sware unto your fathers, hath Jehovah brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you out of the house of bondage, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt. Know therefore that Jehovah thy God, he is God, the faithful God, who keepeth covenant and lovingkindness with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations, and repayeth them that hate him to their face, to destroy them: he will not be slack to him that hateth him, he will repay him to his face. Thou shalt therefore keep the commandment, and the statutes, and the ordinances, which I command thee this day, to do them" (Deut 7:6-12).

Being God's chosen people was filled with joy and hope. Remaining faithful was a substantial choice that Israel had to make. God's pledges were neither frivolous nor vain. When He delivered Israel from bondage in Egypt His pledge was to maintain and care for them. Jehovah's love was extensive and full. God in His great wisdom foresaw Israel's struggles with fidelity. The actions of the nations around them would be temptations. It would take a great heart and devotion on the part of Israel to not wander away from God. Even with the Promised Land and faithfulness on God's part Israel longingly desired the "god" of the heathens and the works of the flesh. To counteract this God gave them a law wherein they would be morally and spiritually fit to preserve a national way of life which would bless and sustain them. Heeding God's commandments was not overwhelming but rather blessed and full of comfort. God's love and mercy would endure through the ages. The "no-gods" were vacillating and capricious. Jehovah was changeless. Choosing Jehovah brought joy without measure "when" they entered the land and reviewed what God had given them. They would "then" see the advantage of being His children and the "apple of His eye".

God gave them a land filled with all that would be needed to become a nation. Temptations were abundant. Israel had to choose to follow God and love Him with all their heart, mind and soul. Forsaking the temptations of being like other nations made them a "peculiar people", an elect race, a royal and holy nation and a people for God's own possession (Deut 10:15; 1 Pet 2:9, 10). Due diligence was compulsory. Children of the tribes of Israel would see the fathers respond to God and in like manner lovingly submit themselves to the gracious God of heaven and earth. Fathers who were uncompromising in their faith assured the children that faithfulness and virtue have their own reward (Deut 6).

Being the holy people of God carries with it a great responsibility. Fulfilling our responsibility grants spiritual blessings wherein God promises He will sustain and care for His own throughout the generations (Heb 13:5, 6; Deut 21:6; Josh 1:5).
