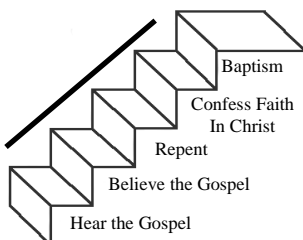

Once, my daughter was about to enjoy, what she thought was sliced cranberries. To her horrific surprise what she actually sampled was a pickled beet. Now, at the mere mention of beets her beautiful face contorts into a squinty eyed mask of revulsion. For her, beets are an abomination.

ABOMINATION! What is this word? It is not used commonly in our daily lives, but is, very frequently, in the Old Testament. Marion-Webster defines it as something regarded with extreme disgust or hatred. Vile, detestable, abhorrent, utterly despised, regarded with extreme repugnance are used in other sources.
