

THE GOSPEL PLAN OF SALVATION

Hear - Romans 10:17 Believe - John 8:24 Repent - Acts 17:30 Confess - Romans 10:10 Be Baptized - Acts 22:16 Saved - in Christ (Galatians 3:27)



This is a continuation from last week talking about "The Sower" found in **Matthew 13:1-23** and today we are going to identify the fourth soil (heart) and our final thoughts.

The fourth soil is the good soil or the good heart. "But he who received seed on the good ground is he who hears the word and understands it, who indeed bears fruit and produces: some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty" Matt. 13:23. The excellent soil (heart) will let the word of God penetrate deeply unto the heart. It will affect one's life and cause this person to bear much fruit, some will bring forth more fruit that others, but all those who have this type of heart will bring forth some fruit. The fruit they bring forth will be equal to their abilities.

Of the four kinds of soil, there is only one that endures. The other three will only survive for a time, and they soon will dissipate into the wind. This is no fault of the sower. The Lord Himself found these same types of hearts while on earth, and they responded in the same manner as they do today. Furthermore, it is not a problem with the seed. The seed is the word of God, and it will always do the job it was ment to do. The seed never changes. The see, when planted, has the same life-giving element in it that it has always had. Corn seed will always produce a stalk of corn. The word (seed) of God will always produce a Christian. Hence, the problem is with the heart of the individual. If the heart is not right, then the word of God cannot abide long enough in the heart to change it from a worldly heart to a Godly heart.

Let us pray for good hearts whereby we can sow the seed of God and produce many more Christians in a world of ungodliness.

So, may we always keep in mind this parable in our lives and learn from it. It does require us to examine our lives to see how we are doing.
