

THE GOSPEL PLAN OF SALVATION

Hear - Romans 10:17 Believe - John 8:24 Repent - Acts 17:30 Confess - Romans 10:10 Be Baptized - Acts 22:16 Saved - in Christ (Galatians 3:27)



Calvinism (Part Nine) – Unconditional Election Doug Post

We have been analyzing what is involved in the heretical system known as Calvinism. If one holds to the doctrine of *Total Hereditary Depravity*, believing all of mankind is so totally depraved they cannot respond to the grace of God, then one must believe in the Calvinistic doctrine of *Unconditional Election* in order to have hope of salvation. John Calvin wrote:

Predestination we call the eternal decree of God, by which he has determined in himself what he would have to become of every individual of mankind. For they are not all created with a similar destiny; but eternal life is fore ordained for some, and eternal damnation for others. Every man, therefore, being created for one or the other of these ends, we say, he is predestined either to life or to death.

That means, before time began, God *chose* Darrell over Doug, and Brenda over Cathy for salvation. This *election* was **unconditional**. Darrell and Brenda did nothing to be saved. God *elected* them to be saved before they were born. Consequently, God *chose* Doug and Cathy to be doomed in hell before they were born. They did not earn it (Rom.6:23).

All four were born totally depraved, not being able to meet any conditions or do anything to be saved because they were so corrupt. So, if any would be saved, it would be totally up to God – on an unconditional basis. Now, this would be a reasonable conclusion to reach IF the underlying premise of Total Hereditary Depravity were true, and if God did not desire to save all instead of some. Of course, we know ALL will not be saved, but that is due to being designed with volition or the ability to make choices – free will – not because God preassigned some to heaven and some to hell.

But friends, the Scriptures teach that God shows no partiality (Acts 10:34-35; Rom. 2:11; 10:12; Eph. 6:9). He shows no favoritism when it comes to the saving of a soul. Obviously, this contradicts the concept of unconditional election. Moreover, the Scriptures also teach God wants everyone to be saved (John 3:16; 1 Tim. 2:4; Tit. 2:11; 2 Pet. 3:9). God desires ALL to be saved, not just some. The Bible is correct here.

ALL rather than some? Why would He preassign SOME to hell if He desires to save ALL? Moreover, what purpose does the Bible, the word of God, serve? Why have the New Testament with all of its commands, warnings, and admonitions about remaining faithful? Why command people to do anything? Why warn them of anything? Why teach faithfulness to God if each individual's eternal destiny has been set? Why does God tell us to *go into all the world and preach the gospel* (Mark 16:15-16)? If one is saved, then he or she cannot fall from grace and be damned. If one is condemned, then he or she cannot change their destiny. Friends, God has not randomly chosen some for heaven and some for hell. But He has predetermined that who obey his gospel and obey his Son will be saved (Heb. 5:9), not the lucky few randomly selected for unconditional salvation. This is why we are to proclaim his gospel to all (Mark 16:15).
