

Last week, a flood stormed through the Isolo Church of Christ building and the apartment of our Bro. Matthew Fola in Nigeria. He has written a description of the destruction. Hopefully, Mission Printing will be able to have some booklets printed for that area soon. If you would like to give some funds to Matthew and Emma and their 3 children, please give it to one of our elders Sunday:

FLOOD in Lagos last Friday. Six hours of a heavy down pour had serious negative effect in the church. It took 12 hours before the gutter we constructed could be visible. The entire area was flooded with water. The few remaining boxes of tracts were soaked. Those we stamped for our coming August 14th house to house evangelism are also soaked. Since Friday I have been trying to dry some despite continuous rain. It has serious effects on my apartment too. My printer and Television were soaked. My 3636 printer and Chairs were outside, all soaked. Shoes and study materials in my room were all destroyed. We are now using church open hall upstairs as living quarters. Since we never insulate it, the cold is too much. The flood destroyed our food stuff rice, cassava powder, Gari, etc. Our foams and bedding are all affected. My daughter who is starting her West Africa Examinations in August lost her notes and text books. The flood affects many of my members too. Today's service was greatly affected as many did not come to service because they are busy washing and cleaning their houses. Now, we have no more tracts for anybody until we receive the 2022 Container. The flood affects me and the church and the Mission Printing tracts too much. Please help inform the church about our ordeal.
