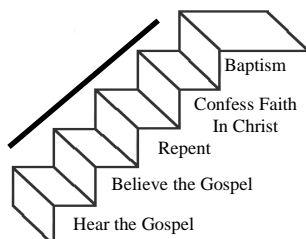

“I WONT TAKE LESS THAN YOUR LOVE”

"How much do I owe you?" said the man to his Lord.

"For giving me this day and every day that's gone before.

"Shall I build a temple, shall I make a sacrifice?

"Tell me Lord and I will pay the price."

And the Lord said: "I won't take less than your love, sweet love.

"No, I won't take less than your love.

"All the treasures of the world could never be enough,

"And I won't take less than your love."

The above comes from a 1987 country song, performed by Paul Overstreet and Tanya Tucker, which captures the essence of Matthew 22:37-39:

1. **“You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.”**
2. **“You shall love your neighbor as yourself.”**

Luke adds another element which Matthew does not: **“You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind”** (Luke 10:27). Of course, the meaning is that we are to love God with every fiber of our being.

The heart is the mind, **“As a man thinks in his heart so is he”** (Proverbs 23:7). Our soul is our inner being, which housed within our flesh, and is the real you and the real me. The apostle Paul refers to our inner being (soul/spirit) as the **“inward man”** (2 Corinthians 4:16; 5:1-3).

Paul adds some Divine commentary to what it means to love God with all our heart, soul, strength, and mind:

“I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God” (Romans 12:1-2).

Our Lord’s sacrificial love for you and me is to be returned. He will not accept anything less.
