

When Jesus was about to send out His disciples to preach the gospel of the coming kingdom, He warned them of the problems they would have and the dangers they would face, but they should not be afraid: "Are not two sparrows sold for a penny? And not one of them will fall to the ground apart from your Father. But even the hairs of your head are all numbered. Fear not, therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows" (Matt.10:29–31). It is comforting to know that we worship and serve a God who knows us personally and cares about us. Since He is intimately involved in everything that concerns our well-being, we may rest in the assurance of His help.

God's love causes Him to be steadfast in the help He gives. He is trustworthy and dependable. We may confidently entrust ourselves to His care, knowing that He will be not only good to us but also wise in His goodness. In the Old Testament, *hesed* ("lovingkindness") is translated as "**steadfast love**." That's exactly what God's love is: a trustworthy love that can be counted on because He has entered into a covenant with us.

Peter wrote, "Therefore let those who suffer according to God's will entrust their souls to a faithful Creator while doing good" (1 Pet. 4:19). Because He "cares" for us, we may cast our "care" upon Him: "Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time he may exalt you, casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you" (1 Pet. 5:6,7). God loves us with a benevolent, active love. When all other sources of help in this world have failed us, our Heavenly Father will be there to graciously fill our needs.

There are those who observe the pain and heartache in the world and question whether God is there, or at least whether He cares. But the evidences of God's concern are literally all around us every day. May we consider, often, how God shows His love by the help He gives us.

This week, let's make it our aim to more fully appreciate the wondrous love with which our God loves us. And let's more fully express our gratitude for His help by devoting ourselves to the work and worship of God.
