

LEARN TO DENY SELF Doug Post

In teaching about the demands of discipleship, Jesus said, "If anyone wishes to come after Me, he must deny himself, and take up his cross daily and follow Me" (Luke 9:23). This summarizes what it means to follow Jesus.

- 1. We must choose to follow Him. He will not force us to be His disciple. We must have the desire to come after Him.
- 2. We must be willing to deny self. Whatever desires, motivations, and goals we have must be made secondary to our primary purpose of following Christ. He must be first in our lives in everything.
- 3. We must be willing to take up our cross daily. Just as Jesus would give His life on the cross for us, we are to give our lives to Him. This is not something we do sporadically or when it is convenient. It is a <u>daily sacrifice</u> and one in which we must be willing even to lay down our lives for Him.

The apostle Paul writes:

"I beseech you, brethren, by the mercies of God that present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God" (Romans 12:1-2).

Note that we are to present ourselves as a sacrifice to God, which involves refusing to be "**conformed**" to the ways, thinking, and actions of the world (Those outside of Christ). Instead we allow ourselves to be "**transformed by the renewing of our mind.**" How do we renew our minds? By allowing God's word to influence our thinking, and in doing so, we **prove** (test, attest, affirm, examine, etc.) His good, acceptable, and perfect **will** (word of God).

Taking up a cross is a big commitment. Most are not willing to do it. We will never do it if we don't make the Lord first in our lives. Let us learn to deny self. Whatever plans and goals we have for ourselves, the Lord's plans for us are far better. Let's be willing to sacrifice anything for Him.
