

WE MUST BE WILLING TO DO GOD'S WILL Doug Post

When Jesus traveled to Jerusalem for the Feast of Booths, He went to the temple and taught (John 7:14). The Jews "were astonished" at His teaching because, in their minds, He had "never been educated" (John 7:15).

However, Jesus explained that what He taught was from the Father (John 7:16). Even though He did not have any advanced formal training, not having attended a formal "Bible School," He was nonetheless, spiritually educated.

Jesus would make known to all the teaching He received from above – from His Father. However, one would need the proper mindset in order to accept it. This requires a willingness to learn and understand. When it comes to religious matters, topics, and issues, many are "dug in" when it comes to the things they have been taught.

Therefore, rather than listening and trying to understand what someone is saying, they are, instead, thinking of ways to counter what is being said, so they can defeat it. This destroys communication and at the same time refuses to consider what is being said.

That was true then and it is still true today. Jesus said, "If anyone is willing to do His will, he will know of the teaching, whether it is of God or whether I speak from Myself" (John 7:17). Moreover, Jesus also said that we should be careful how we hear (Luke 8:18), and to be careful what we hear (Mark 4:24).

If one is not willing to follow the Lord, He will find any excuse – no matter how weak – for not accepting His instructions. The Lord has given His word, not just so we would believe it, but obey it. This requires humility on our part and a willingness to change our lives to match His word.

So we must be willing to do God's will. We need to decide if we think our ways are better than God's ways. If we recognize that His way is best, we need to humble ourselves and submit to His will. However, this will not occur if we are not listening and paying attention.
